Background

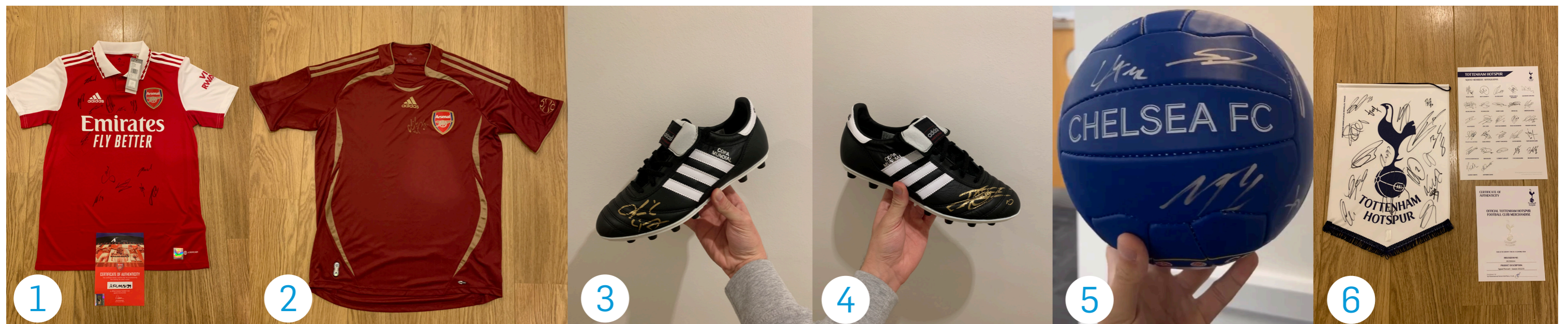
Dan and Derry will be taking on the London Marathon in support of Nerve Tumours UK! Derry will be running in 2023 and Dan in 2024. This charity is very close to our hearts. My brother and close friend of Derry, Patrick suffers with a very rare condition called NF2 (Neurofibromatosis type 2). 1 in 33,000 people worldwide suffer with this condition and there is very little research, support and understanding around it. Nerve Tumours UK has been a strong pillar of support for my brother and other people with similar conditions, so we feel that the support for this charity is extremely important and would like to raise awareness for their cause and the conditions they focus on.

My brother was diagnosed with NF2 when he was 7 years old but has had it since birth. For Pat, NF2 has caused tumours to grow on his lower and upper spine, as well as on his acoustic nerves in both ears. Pat has had 2 major spinal surgeries (lasting around 11 hours each) to remove some of the tumour; 1 head surgery to remove the tumour in his left ear; and so many other surgeries to help treat the symptoms of his condition.

For Pat and many others with similar conditions, Nerve Tumours UK is an extremely supportive structure, providing support and funding for specialist nurses and scientific research.

We appreciate these are difficult times for the best of us, but please consider donating to this cause. All proceeds from the raffle will go to the charity and will also support research into preventing and treating those with these conditions.
