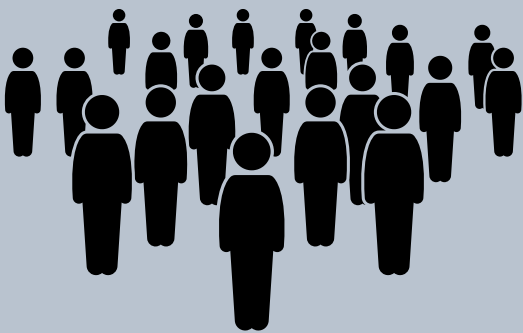


What are the support needs, and preferences for the delivery of support, of **parents and carers** of those with a **visible difference**?

In 2022 a team at the Centre for Appearance Research (CAR), conducted an online survey that was completed by **593 people** with a visible difference (550 adults and 43 parents/carers of children and young people with a condition or injury that impacts on appearance). This is a summary of what we learnt from **43 parents and carers** who told us they had a child with a **visible difference**.

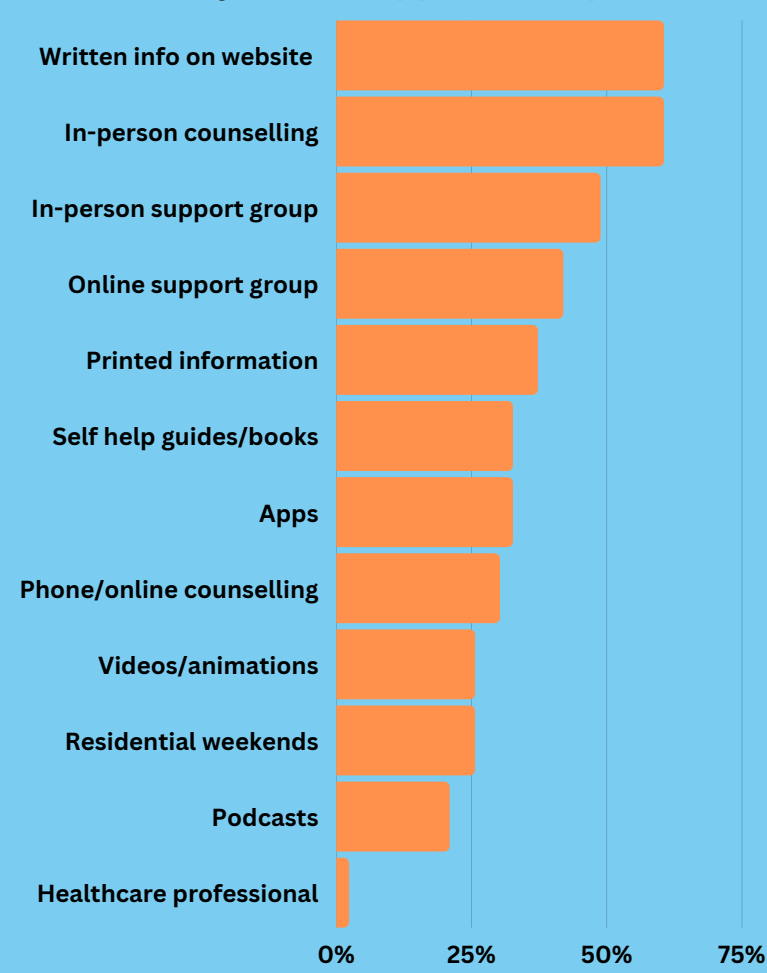

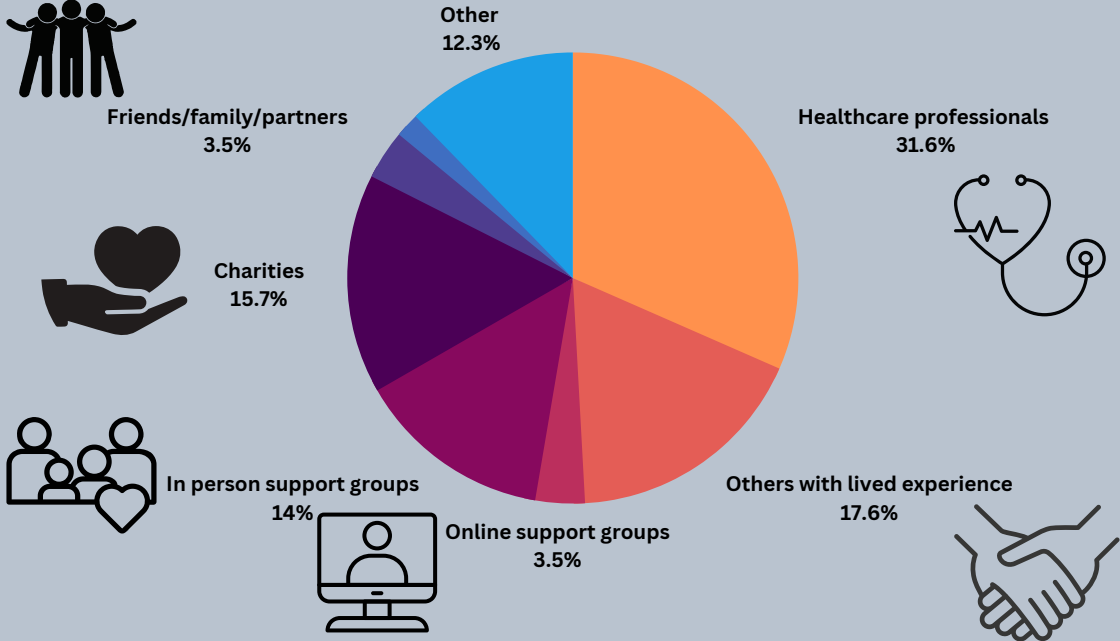
What would you like support with?



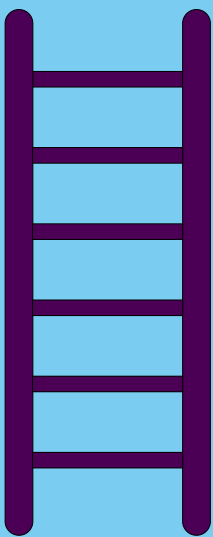
How would you like support to be provided?
