- Start early research courses and support services
- Apply through UCAS don't skip the 'disability' section (it helps, not hurts!)
- Apply for Student Finance + Disabled Students Allowance (DSA)
- **Contact uni disability services** about housing and adjustments
- Talk to tutors and advisors early they're there to help
